



## #WYHUNTFISH-Wood River Turkey Hunt

The #WYHUNTFISH-Wood River Turkey Hunt is a Mentored Program that teaches youth and adults the basic hunting skills used in turkey hunting and then puts these skills to use on a Mentored Turkey Hunt on private ranches in the Wood River Valley west of Meeteetse, Wyoming during the spring 2022 turkey season that runs from 20 April through 31 May.

Successful Applicants will begin their journey, with the guidance of their Mentor, learning and practicing safe firearm handling skills along with turkey calling and hunting techniques at a Range Day held on Saturday April 2<sup>nd</sup> 2022. This range day will last approximately 5 hours and will include both a classroom session along with a shooting session on the range.

The second step in this journey will be an actual Turkey Hunt on a private ranch west of Meeteetse, Wyoming. You will be accompanied by your mentor who will support your hunt by helping you find where and how to hunt and by using calls to locate and lure in the birds.

The only cost to the participants is that you will need to purchase your Wyoming Game and Fish Turkey License and Conservation Stamp. And provide your own transportation to the April 2<sup>nd</sup> Range Day near Cody and to Meeteetse for your day of hunting. For Wyoming residents that have maintained their continuous residency for the past 365 days the combined cost of your license and Conservation Stamp will be \$37.50. For non-residents the combined cost will be \$95.50.

All of the other items needed to participate in this program are provided free of charge by the program's sponsors and organizers along with your Mentor. **You do NOT need your own firearm or other hunting supplies to participate.**

The #WYHUNTFISH-Wood River Turkey Hunt is a collaboration between Wyoming Game and Fish, First Hunt Foundation and Wyoming Outdoorsmen. The combined efforts of these three organizations make this fantastic program possible.
