



The Spring Creek Pronghorn Hunt is a mentored program that teaches youth and adults the basic hunting skills used in pronghorn (aka antelope) hunting, and then puts these skills to use on a mentored hunt on private ranches in Southeast, Wyoming near Cheyenne during the fall 2022 Antelope season.

Successful Applicants will begin their journey, with the guidance of their Mentor, learning and practicing safe firearm handling skills and beginning marksmanship skills at a **Range Day scheduled for Saturday, 30 July**. This range day will be held near Cheyenne, Wyoming and will last approximately 5 hours. The second step in your journey will be a Simulated Hunt Program during which you will walk through a course that simulates hunting, stalking, and shooting at Antelope size targets. This **event is scheduled on Saturday, 20 August** and will also be held near Cheyenne, Wyoming.

Your experience will culminate with an actual Antelope Hunt on a private ranch west of Cheyenne. The hunt will take place starting in October through late December 2022 on dates to be agreed with your mentor. You will have the opportunity to try to harvest your first Big Game Animal and will be accompanied by your mentor who will support your hunting efforts.

The only cost to the participants is that you will need to apply for and purchase your Wyoming Game and Fish Antelope license and conservation stamp, provide your own transportation to the Range Day and the Simulated Hunt, and to the Cheyenne area for your day of hunting. For Wyoming residents that have maintained their continuous residency for the past 365 days the combined cost of your license and conservation stamp will be \$63.50. For non-residents the combined cost will be \$362.50.

All of the other items needed to participate in this program are provided free of charge by the program's sponsors and organizers along with your Mentor. You do NOT need your own firearm or other hunting supplies to participate.

The Spring Creek Hunt is a collaboration between First Hunt Foundation and Wyoming Game and Fish and made possible by generous donations from SOS Well Services, the WY Wildlife Foundation, Wyoming Women's Foundation, and the WYLDlife Fund.
